AT THIS TIME THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING:

- Any items not at the curb at 7:00 am.
- Any items not packaged correctly.
- oil/anti-freeze containers
- wax coated milk/juice containers
- frozen food packages
- packing "peanuts"
- pottery
- batteries (rechargeable)
- china/crystal
- styrofoam
- pots/pans
- Any plastic item without a number.
- hangers
- window glass
- paint cans
- light bulbs
- used oil
- books
- flower pots
- toys
- driveway sealer cans

BULK PICK UP IS FOR HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY.

Bulk pick up is at the curb and must be available by 7:00 am.
IF YOU HAVE A LARGE PICK UP, PLEASE CALL BEFORE PLACING AT CURBSIDE.
NO BULK PICK UP DURING HOLIDAY WEEKS.
Bulk shall not be placed at curbside any earlier than 3 days prior to your pick up day.

The following items are not included for bulk pick up:

- paint
 - liquids
 - masonry
 - used oil
 - chemicals
 - stumps
 - lumber
 - batteries
 - fencing
 - trees
 - logs
 - stone
 - windows
 - grass
 - brick
 - propane tanks
 - tires
- Construction, renovation or remodeling debris including kitchens, baths, decks and windows.

PAINT

Household Paint- Preparation is Important!

Think of the potential mess a can of liquid paint can cause to the road, a truck or sanitation crew if it spills or splatters. Both oil-based paint and water-based or latex paint may be legally and safely disposed of in your garbage by following the simple instructions below.

How to Prepare a Can of Paint for Disposal in the Garbage

Empty Can of Paint: Put it out next to the garbage with the lid off.*

(Do not include the empty can with your recyclables.)

Can With Paint: Harden paint by mixing it with kitty litter or another absorbent pellet material (such as Speedy-Dri) until no liquid remains. The more absorbent material added, the faster the paint will harden. To make more room for the absorbent material, full or partially full cans of paint should be poured off into empty cans or ones with less paint. Some paint stores may carry products specifically designed to harden waste paint. Ask stores for details.

After the paint is hard, put it out for garbage collection with the lid off.*

Rugs MUST be cut, rolled and tied so that no roll is longer than 4FT.
REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS and A/C UNITS MUST have the FREON PROFESSIONALLY REMOVED and properly labeled before pickup.
Consult the Yellow Pages.

REGULAR GARBAGE must be available for collection by 7:00 am. All garbage must be in heavy duty outdoor plastic bags, placed in watertight receptacles. Curbside collection MUST be within 4 feet of the road. Back door collection will be made only when the driveway is free of all snow, vehicles and other obstacles. Only the driver can determine if the driveway can be negotiated safely. If your driveway is inaccessible due to any of the above conditions, we suggest that you put materials for that collection day at the curb. **Back door service and twice-weekly pick up are available.** For information call our office: 914-698-4300.

Garbage receptacles shall not be placed at the curb any earlier than 12 hours prior to pick up and must be removed no later than 12 hours after collection. All garbage receptacles shall be kept in good repair.

COLLECTION WILL BE LIMITED TO 4 THIRTY-TWO GALLON CONTAINERS PER STOP EACH WEEK







RECYCLING materials must be available for collection by 7:00 am. If you are a back door customer, your recycling will also be picked up at your back door. The recycling pick up schedule is observed during inclement weather.

Newspapers, magazines, clean pizza boxes, phone books and junk mail must be commingled and placed in brown paper bags or tied with cord in bundles not higher than 10 inches. Corrugated cardboard must be broken down, cut, separated and banded not higher than 10 inches and not wider than 36 inches in either direction.

Glass bottles (all colors), all aluminum, tin and metal cans, clean foil, pie plates, plastic containers only numbered 1-6 should be rinsed. Plastic bags (numbers 1-6) only are acceptable. All items are to be commingled in blue tinted recycling bags which are available at most local supermarkets and hardware stores.
