

Waste and Recycling

COLLECTION INFORMATION

North Castle recycling legislation requires every individual, business, organization and institution to source separate:

- 1) paper products
- 2) commingled glass, cans and plastic #1-6
- 3) waste

Waste and recycling containers must not be larger than 32 gallons.

ALL WASTE AND RECYCLING material must be available by 7:00 am on collection day.

Curbside Pick Up:

Waste and recycling containers must be off the street and within 4 feet of the curb.
Waste and recycling containers shall not be placed at the curb any earlier than 12 hours prior to pick up and must be removed no later than 12 hours after collection.
All waste and recycling containers must be in good repair.

Back Door Pick Up: Back door waste and recycling collection will be made only when the driveway is free of all snow, vehicles and other obstacles. Only the driver can determine if the driveway can be negotiated safely. If your driveway is inaccessible, please put your waste and recycling at the curb that day.

Back door service and twice-weekly pick ups are available for a fee. For more information call 914-698-4300.

Waste

All waste must be in heavy duty plastic bags, preferably clear, and placed in watertight receptacles.

BULK PICK UP

Bulk pick up is for household items only.
Bulk items must be at the curb by 7:00 am.
IF YOU HAVE A LARGE PICK UP, PLEASE CALL 914-698-4300 BEFORE PLACING AT CURBSIDE.
NO BULK PICK UP OCCURS DURING HOLIDAY WEEKS.
Bulk items shall not be placed at curbside any earlier than 3 days prior to your pick up day.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR CURBSIDE BULK PICK UP:

chemicals	fencing	windows	tires
stumps	trees	grass	bricks
masonry	lumber	logs	propane tanks
used oil	batteries	stone	

construction, renovation or remodeling debris of any kind

PAINT

Household paint cans must be dried before collection to avoid spills and splatters.
Harden paint by mixing with kitty litter or another absorbent pellet material.
After paint is hard, put out for collection with the lid off.

Rugs and carpet must be cut in pieces no WIDER than 4 feet.

AT THIS TIME THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE CONSIDERED WASTE:

wax coated milk/food containers	pottery
frozen food packages	china/crystal
packing "peanuts"	styrofoam
all car batteries	

Cardboard & Paper

You must recycle

- Newspaper, Magazines, Paper Bags
- Phone Books, Catalogs, Junk Mail
- Office Paper, Envelopes
- Corrugated Cardboard Boxes (remove tape and styrofoam)
- Cereal, Pasta, Gift, Shoe Boxes



How to prepare cardboard & paper for pick up

Choose any or a combination of the following options:

1. Place items directly in your existing recycling bin or an old garbage pail. Clearly mark "Recycling." "Recycling" stickers are available at Town Hall.
2. Create a bundle by tying newspaper and other materials with cord or twine, no higher than 10 inches and no longer than 36 inches, or place paper materials in paper bags.
3. Place empty appliance, pizza, gift boxes and packing boxes directly out for collection.



Do not put paper items in plastic bags at curbside

Glass, Cans & Plastic #1-6

You must recycle

- Glass Bottles (clear and colored)
- Foil Pie Plates & Aluminum Foil
- Metal Bottle Caps
- Cans Including Empty Aerosol Cans
- Any Plastics #1-6



How to prepare glass, cans and plastic #1-6 for pick up

Choose one or both of the following options:

1. Place items directly in your existing recycling pail or an old garbage pail. Clearly mark "Recycling." "Recycling" stickers are available at Town Hall.
2. Place items in clear or blue (recycling) bags and put bag out for collection.



Everything must be rinsed.

Do not use white or black bags for recycling
