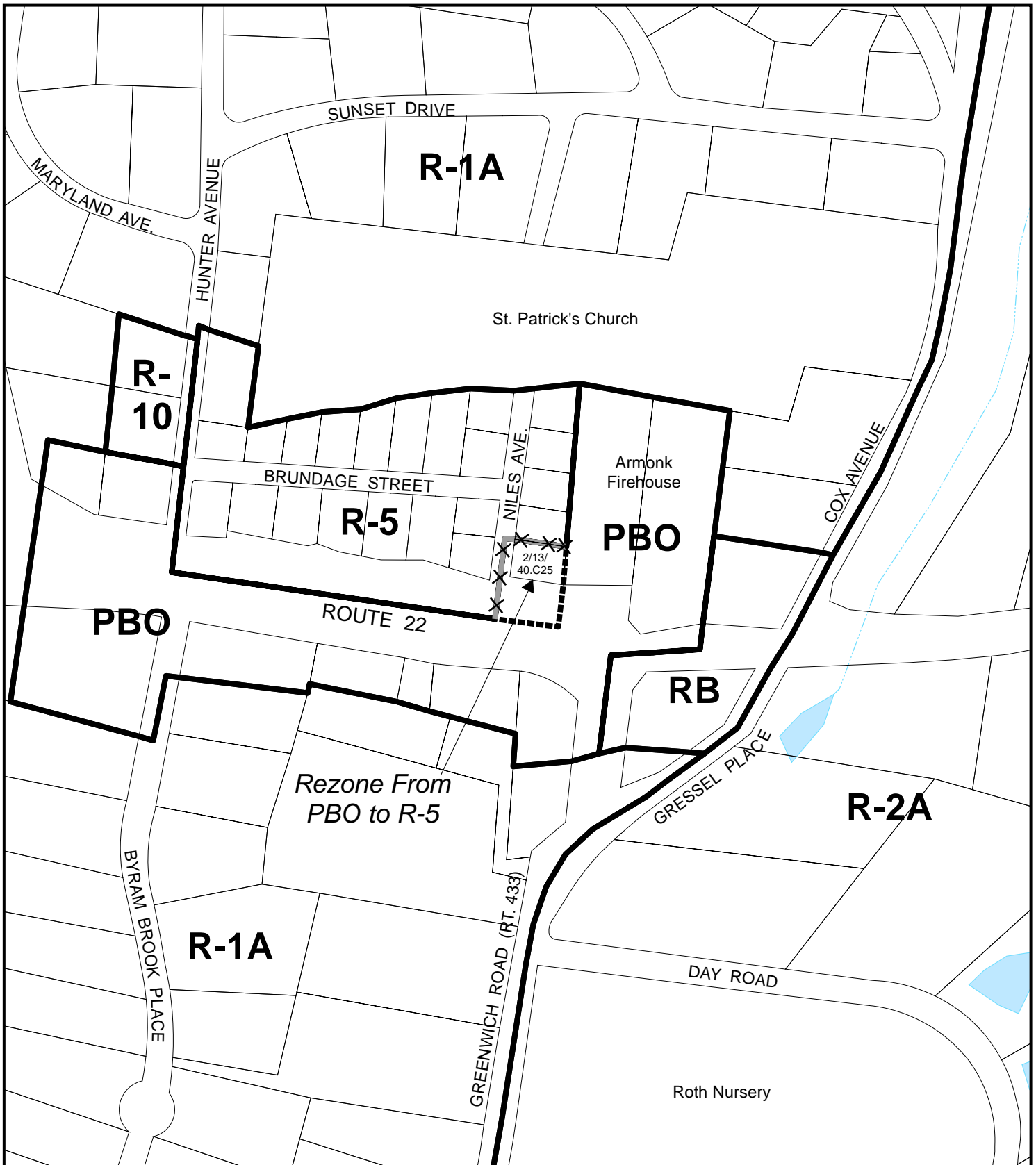

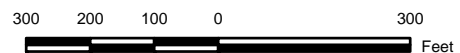
**Legend**
