The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on March 7, 2017.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- Provide construction details for all proposed improvements, including, but not limited to, patio, walkways, erosion controls, etc.
- Provide proposed grading associated with the proposed patio and addition.
- Provide a copy of the Westchester County Department of Health (WCHD) approval for the proposed modifications to the on-site wastewater treatment system.
- Disturbance of over 5,000 s.f. will require an Erosion Control SWPPP in accordance with Chapter 173 Stormwater Management of the Town Code. Additionally, disturbances over 1 acre will require conformance with NYSDEC General Permit G-0-15-002 and filing of a Notice of Intent (NOI) and MS4 Acceptance Form with the NYSDEC. Submit copies to the Town Engineer for review.
- All trees 8 inches dbh or greater located within or 10 feet beyond the proposed limit of disturbance shall be shown on the plan. Indicate trees to be removed and/or protected.
- Silt fence shall be installed parallel to existing topography.

At this time you may submit plans for the proposed project to the North Castle Planning Board.
