The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on March 4, 2014.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The plan shall illustrate and quantify the limits of disturbance. The plan shall note that disturbance limits shall be staked in the field prior to construction.
- Provide a copy of the Westchester County Department of Health (WCHD) approval for the proposed
  modifications to the on-site wastewater treatment system and drilled well. The applicant should
  verify that the proposed driveway layout will meet WCHD standards.
- Demonstrate that the required 50 foot minimum setback between the level spreader, footing drain and the well are met.
- The original development required the filing of a Notice of Intent (NOI). The current owner should provide status of the NOI and any supporting documentation (Notice of Transfer, Notice of Termination, etc.), as required by the NYSDEC.
- GLC worksheet and backup data don't agree and should be revised. 13,159 on worksheet 13,119 on backup.

At this time you may coordinate directly with the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.
