The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on April 3, 2018.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The existing sewer connection shall be sleeved for protection from vehicle loading in the location of the proposed driveway. Provide a detail.
- The plan shall illustrate and quantify the limits of disturbance. The plan shall note that disturbance limits shall be staked in the field prior to construction.
- Show all required minimum yard setbacks on the plan.
- Provide existing and proposed topography for the area of work.
- All trees 8 inches dbh or greater located within or 10 feet beyond the proposed limit of disturbance shall be shown on the plan. Indicate trees to be removed and/or protected.
- Include erosion control measures on the plan, including, but not limited to, temporary construction access, silt fence, inlet protection, tree protection, erosion control blankets, construction sequence, etc. Provide details.

At this time you may coordinate directly with the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.
