The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on October 20, 2015.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The site plan shall be revised to depict location of zoning district boundary lines.
- The pool equipment is located in side yard setback, which is not permitted. The equipment shall be relocated to be outside of any required yard or a variance will need to be obtained from the ZBA.
- Clarify all existing site improvements, including, but not limited to, grading, drainage, etc.
- The plan shall illustrate and quantify the limits of disturbance. The plan shall note that disturbance limits shall be staked in the field prior to construction.
- The applicant shall perform deep and percolation soil testing to be witnessed by the Town Engineer. The test locations and results shall be shown on the plan. Contact the Town Engineer to schedule the testing.
- Provide rims, inverts, size and material for all drainage facilities.

At this time you may coordinate directly with the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.
