The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on July 18, 2017.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The Applicant shall submit a site plan prepared by a NYS licensed professional depicting the location of the proposed deck. The deck shall be no closer to five feet from the rear property line per the approved subdivision map for the development (see building file).
- The 1,830 square feet of gross land coverage exceeds the maximum permitted amount of 1,210 square feet of gross land coverage. The Applicant will need to reduce the size of the proposed deck or seek a variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals.
- Submission of gross land coverage backup information.
- The applicant shall secure any required HOA approvals needed to provide construction access to the rear of the building.
- Show all required minimum yard setbacks on the plan.

At this time you may coordinate directly with the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.
