The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on November 3, 2015.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The wall detail notes a maximum height of 8 feet. Walls over 6 feet within the property setbacks are not permitted. The plans shall be revised to depict compliance with the Town Code.
- The plan shall illustrate and quantify the limits of disturbance. The plan shall note that disturbance limits shall be staked in the field prior to construction.
- The wall detail should show any required penetration and/or protection measures for the septic effluent pipe.
- A Tree Permit will be required.
- The Town Wetland Consultant will need to confirm the local wetland boundary shown on the plan. Notify this office once the wetland boundary has been established in the field.
- The proposed fence on the top of the wall shall be off-set from the edge of the wall to the satisfaction of the Building Department.

At this time you may coordinate directly with the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.
