The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC) on June 17, 2014.

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The Applicant will need to submit the required GLC and GFA backup information.
- The site plan should be revised to include a zoning conformance chart.
- The plan shall illustrate and quantify the limits of disturbance. The plan shall note that disturbance limits shall be staked in the field prior to construction.
- Show all required minimum yard setbacks on the plan.
- Show the location of the existing well, septic tank, etc. Demonstrate that the required setbacks to the infiltration system are met.
- Include erosion control measures on the plan, including, but not limited to, temporary construction access, silt fence, inlet protection, tree protection, erosion control blankets, construction sequence, etc. Provide details.
- The plan shall show septic area to be cordoned off during construction.
- Any wall over four feet in height shall be designed to the satisfaction of the Town Engineer.

At this time you may coordinate directly with the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.
