Chabad of Armonk is a Jewish organization that has been active in the local Armonk community for over five years. It is currently seeking to rent a location that would serve as the central base of its activities in the community.

While for larger events Chabad would continue to rent venues such as the Brynwood Club, the La Quinta Inn or the local public school, the center would be used for some of Chabad's more ongoing events.

These activities break themselves down to three areas:

- Chabad offers weekly classes which attract between 10 and 15 people. The topics of these classes range from Jewish mysticism to practical educational classes, such as Hebrew reading and Bar or Bat Mitzvah training.
- Once a week Chabad operates a Hebrew school for about twenty children. The parents drop the children off at about 4:00 pm and pick them up at 6:00 pm. The parents do not remain present during the operating hours of Hebrew School.
- On Friday evenings Chabad hosts Shabbat services, which begin at 6:30 pm during the winter, and 7:00 pm during the summer. The services usually attract about ten to fifteen people and last for about forty five minutes.

We ask for your help and consideration in making this center a reality so that we may do our part in strengthening the educational, moral, and cultural fibers of the community. It is our goal to do everything within our capacity to make the world a better place for all people.
