Afternoon Tea & Tour of the Morgan Library & Museum & Beatrix Potter Exhibit, NYC

Tuesday, June 4, 2024 (Registration Deadline: May 17)

We'll journey to the Morgan Library & Museum on 36th St. in NYC and start our day with a lovely Afternoon Tea which includes Tea Sandwiches, Scones, Sweets, Preserves, Clotted Cream, Harney & Sons Tea.

We'll enjoy a guided tour featuring an overview of the Morgan's history, architecture, historic buildings, library and collections. The Morgan Library & Museum began as the personal library of financier, collector and cultural benefactor Pierpont Morgan. As early as 1890, Morgan began to assemble a collection of illuminated, literary and historical manuscripts, early printed books and old master drawings and prints.

Our self-guided tour of the *Beatrix Potter: Drawn to Nature* exhibit brings together, artwork, books, manuscripts and artifacts from several institutions, paired with the Morgan's exceptional collection of her picture letters. These objects trace how Potter's innovative blend of scientific observations and imaginative storytelling shaped some of the world's most popular children's books including unforgettable animal characters like Peter Rabbit, Mr. Jeremy Fish and Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle, Tom Kitten and Jemima Puddle-Duck.
