

Recycling 101

Recyclable

Plastic & Glass

Rinsed plastic bottles must have the recycling triangle with the #1 , #2, #3, #4, #5, #6

Rinsed plastic containers must have the recycling triangle with the #1 , #2, #3, #4, #5, #6

Rinsed glass bottles

Rinsed aluminum beer & soda cans

Rinsed vegetable & soup cans

Rinsed Plastic jugs recycling triangle with the #1 , #2, #3, #4, #5, #6

Rinsed glass jars (remove metal lids)

Rinsed metal jar lids (separated from jar)

Rinsed plastic laundry detergent jugs must have the recycling triangle with the #1 , #2, #3, #4, #5, #6

Rinsed plastic bottle tops

Empty aerosol cans

Rinsed plastic and metal coffee cans

Cardboard & Paper

Clean & Dry cardboard boxes

Clean & Dry fed-Ex boxes & envelopes (that do not have plastic attached to them)

Clean & Dry UPS boxes & envelopes (that do not have plastic attached to them)

Clean & Dry direct mail

Clean & Dry brown paper bags

Clean & Dry Cereal boxes

Clean & Dry pasta boxes

Clean & Dry magazines

Shoe boxes(tissue and packaging must removed)

Clean & Dry window envelopes

Non- soiled aluminum foil

Clean & Dry News paper

No plastic bags (even if it has a recycling symbol)
No Styrofoam (even if it has a recycling symbol)
No wax cardboard (dark brown film is wax)
No Styrofoam egg cartons
No paper towel or toilet paper rolls (cores)
No carton material (coffee cup carriers or sleeves)
No plastic hangers
No metal hangers
No potting buckets or plastic gardening containers
No coffee cups
No coffee cup lids
No coffee cup hot sleeves
No coffee cups stirrers
No aseptic containers (ice cream, milk, juice, soup, broth etc.)
No frozen food cartons

No plastic packaging material
No shrink wrap
No potatoes chip bags or snack bags
No laundry baskets (even if they have a recycling symbol)
No large plastic items
No Fed Ex or UPS envelopes with a combination of paper & plastic combined
No metal furniture
No pizza boxes
No plastic straws
No medical waste
No prescription bottles
No food Waste
No textile
No kitchen cooking pots or frying pans
No plastic kitchen utensils
No forks, knives or spoons
No stainless steel or metal kitchen utensils
No electronic waste
No cell phones
No rechargeable batteries
No alkaline batteries
No porcelain items
No ceramic items
No lamps
No metal furniture

No paint cans
No tires
No car batteries
No Styrofoam peanuts
No aluminum container soiled with food residue
No aluminum container lids soiled with food
No plastic kids toys (even if it has a number)
No magnets

No dirt or soil
No brush
No compostable flatware
No compostable plates, bowls or cups

No plastic soda/water caps
