Restoration

- 1.) Road must be STEP saw cut with a 18"cut back on each side of the excavation trench.
- 2.) 12" of Item 4 Compacted in 3" lifts
- 3.) Minimum 4'binder compacted (Must call Highway when you are doing the work)
- 4.) Minimum 2.5'top compacted
- 5.) Crack fill Joints

Bond

Bond will be held for a period of six months after restoration has been completed to make sure no settling has taken place.

<u>UNDER THE NY STATE LAW PROTECTING UNDERGROUND FACILITIES, THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REG-ULATIONS ARE IN EFFECT FOR ALL EXCAVATORS:</u> They must call for a utility stake-out (2) two full working days prior to an excavation.

They must confirm precise locations of underground facilities.

They must preserve stakes and markings until no longer needed at site and then remove any stakes or flags.

They must contact non-UFPO member utility owners for stake-outs.

IN THE EVENT OF NEGLIGENCE OR NONCOMPLIANCE, EXCAVATORS ARE:

Liable to utility owners for the cost(s) of a dig up.

Liable for fines up to \$7500 and can be enjoined from further work.
