The Local Law for consideration.

Board of Ethics Chair Brett Summers provided background that the proposed amendments to the Code of Ethics would increase the number of board members and elected officials who would be required to submit Disclosure Statements and increase the scope of the Disclosure Statements.

A discussion was held regarding who will have access to the Disclosure Statements and regarding efforts to ensure transparency weighed against privacy concerns.

The Town Board confirmed that elected officials and specified board members would be required to disclose interests in properties that they know to be currently before a Board of the Town for consideration, and, upon learning of a potential conflict, would be required to submit a Disclosure Statement.

Board of Ethics members Sue Shimer and Ed Lobermann expressed support of the proposed amendments.

Residents Jennifer Clark and Andrew Reiskind expressed support for the proposed amendments.

Resident Linda Fernberg expressed opposition to the proposed amendments.

After all persons were heard who desired to be heard, Councilman Milim moved, seconded by Councilman Berra, that the Public Hearing be closed at 10:31 p.m.

TOWN OF NORTH CASTLE

LOCAL LAW NO. <u>10</u> OF 2022 Adopted October 26, 2022

A Local Law to amend Chapter 27, Code of Ethics, Sections 27-2 and 27-6 E. of the Code of the Town of North Castle.

Be It Enacted by the Town Board of the Town of North Castle as follows:

Section 27-2 of the Code of the Town of North Castle entitled "Definitions" at "Interest" is hereby amended as follows:

INTEREST

A direct or indirect financial or material benefit, but does not include any benefit arising from the provision or receipt of any services generally available to the residents or taxpayers of the municipality or an area of the municipality, or a lawful class of such residents or taxpayers. A municipal officer or employee is deemed to have an interest in any organization including, but not limited to when he or she or his or her relative directly or indirectly (e.g., individually or through one or more organizations and/or as a grantor, beneficiary or trustee of one or more trusts) (i) is a partner, member, or other full or partial owner, (ii) is a director, officer, manager or employee, (iii) owns or controls more than 5% of the outstanding stock of a publicly traded corporation.

Section 2.

Section 27-6 E. of the Code of the Town of North Castle entitled "Disclosure of interest in legislation and other matters" is hereby amended as follows:

Upon election or appointment and thereafter on an annual basis, the following individuals shall watch a brief Town of North Castle ethics training video, which shall be consistent with the Code of Ethics, and complete a Town of North Castle Disclosure Statement materially in the form attached as Appendix A: elected officials, members of the Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, Architectural Review Board, and Board of Assessment Review.

Conflicting Standards.

Where the requirements of this Local Law impose a different restriction or requirement than imposed by other sections of the Code of the Town of North Castle, the Town Law of the State of New York or other applicable rules or regulations, the requirements of this Local Law shall prevail.

Section 4. Severability.

The invalidity of any word, section, clause, paragraph, sentence, part or provision of this local law shall not affect the validity of any other part of this local law that can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

<u>Section 5.</u> Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and filing with the Secretary of State.

The term "Interest" includes any financial or material benefit or thing of value, except for such things which are generally available to all residents or taxpayers, or even a large group of such individuals. Financial or material benefits may be received or provided directly, but they also include such benefits that are received or provided indirectly.

For organizations other than a publicly traded corporation, an example of a "direct" <u>Interest</u> is where a town official, employee or volunteer is a partner, member or has another type of ownership interest in that organization or is a director, officer, manager or employee in such an organization. For organizations other than a publicly traded corporation, an example of an "indirect" <u>Interest</u> is where that town official, employee or volunteer holds that same <u>Interest</u>, but through one or more organizations or through one or more trusts — either as a grantor, beneficiary or trustee.
