The Local Law for consideration.

Councilman DiGiacinto provided background that she initiated this proposed local law in an effort to promote pollinator gardens and, upon review of the legislation and discussion with Director of Planning Adam Kaufman and Building Inspector Rob Melillo, determined that pollinator gardens are already governed in the Town Code within the definition of cultivated flowers and gardens.

Following discussion the Board determined that the proposed law would in fact be more restrictive than the existing local law, and therefore agreed not to adopt the proposed amendments.

Resident Leith Colton expressed support for pollinator gardens and noted the positive impacts they have on the environment.

The proposed local law was not adopted.

After all persons were heard who desired to be heard, Councilman DiGiacinto moved, seconded by Councilman Hussain, that the Public Hearing be closed at 8:42 p.m.
