Tax Assessor Victoria Sirota provided an update regarding the 2019 STAR Exemption.

An overview of the 57th annual Armonk Outdoor Art Show was presented by Executive Director Anne Curran and Barbara Vircillo, President of the Friends of the North Castle Public Library. It was stated that The Art Show has received national acclaim and, with funds raised at the Art Show, the Friends have funded close to \$700,000 of library programs and furnishings in the past 5 years. The funds sponsor the Armonk Players, our local theater group, as well as over 2000 programs at both the Armonk and North White Plains branches of the library.

A Public Hearing was held to consider a Special Event Permit application of Haunted Dead End for a Halloween Special Event at Rocky Ledge Swim Club, 1402 Old Orchard Street, to be open to the public on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays during the month of October.

A Public Hearing was opened to consider a Local Law to Amend Chapter 355, Zoning to permit the Planning Board to accept a cash payment to the Town in lieu of providing some, or all, of the required amount of off-street parking on a subject property.

RESOLUTION TO DECLARE LEAD AGENCY

Town of North Castle Sewer District No. 2 Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Adopted September 12, 2018

WHEREAS, The Town of North Castle proposes to undertake the following action on the Sewer District No. 2 Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project, located in the Town of North Castle:

- Replacement and upgrades of equipment.
- Improvement of treatment processes.
- Improvement of existing infrastructure.
- The installation of the following new buildings and tankage:
 - o One primary clarifier
 - o One equalization tank
 - o One nitrifying Rotating Biological Contactor (RBC) train
 - o Two denitrifying filter cells
 - o One Administration Building
 - o Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) Adsorption System

(hereinafter referred to as "said Action"), and;

WHEREAS said Action requires review under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), per 6NYCRR Part 617, and;

WHEREAS said Action is defined as an Unlisted Action under 6NYCRR Part 617 because the action is not listed under 6NYCRR Part 617.4 or 617.5, and;

WHEREAS the involved agencies include the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (hereafter "NYSDEC"), Westchester County Department of Health, and the Town of North Castle, New York, and;

WHEREAS 6NYCRR Part 617.6(b)(3) calls for a coordinated review of an Unlisted Action, and;

WHEREAS 6NYCRR Part 617.6(b)(2)(i) requires that a Lead Agency for a coordinated review of an Unlisted Action be established prior to a determination of significance, and;

WHEREAS 6NYCRR Part 617.2(u) defines "Lead Agency" as, "an involved agency principally responsible for undertaking funding or approving an action, and therefore responsible for determining whether an environmental impact statement is required in connection with the action, and for the preparation and filing of the statement if one is required", and;

WHEREAS the Town of North Castle intends to act as Lead Agency in the coordinated review of said Action as an Unlisted Action under SEQRA and further intends to implement and complete all responsibilities as lead agency,

Therefore, upon a motion duly made by Councilman Barbara DiGiacinto, seconded by Councilman José Berra and a vote was held with the following results: Unanimous, it is
