Town Board Minutes Town of North Castle Online at NCTV Armonk, New York on April 15, 2020

The Town Board meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. online via web conference due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, and the following persons were present:

Westchester County Executive George Latimer provided an update regarding the number of cases in and the impact of Coronavirus on Westchester County, and the various government resources delivered in response to the virus.

County Legislator Margaret Cunzio also spoke about resources, and working with the County Executive to get the equipment needed to volunteer fire departments, ambulance corps, police departments and first responders. Ms. Cunzio thanked Supervisor Schiliro for the mask drive he conducted.

Supervisor Schiliro and Town Board members recognized the heroic efforts of hospital workers and first responders; and also recognized the Town's residents, businesses, and employees, including its first responders, for their help to the community during these unprecedented times.

Supervisor Schiliro asked for donations of masks for healthcare workers. He put a drop box in his front yard where, over the course of 2 months, residents and employees deposited over 600 handmade and store bought masks which were then distributed to local hospitals.

A Public Hearing was reconvened to consider a Local Law for a Comprehensive Town Code Update to amend various Chapters of the Town Code to improve the administration of the Code by the Building Department.

The minutes of the Public Hearing which reconvened at 8:41 p.m. follow at the end of these minutes.

# RESOLUTION: TOWN OF NORTH CASTLE – APRIL 15, 2020 IN CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION TO PROVIDE RELIEF FOR PROPERTY TAXPAYERS DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the Westchester County Board of Legislators is considering a Local Law amending Chapter 283 of the Laws of Westchester County relating to Westchester County Tax Law; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Relief Legislation is being considered because of the substantial negative impact on businesses, residents, and local municipalities due to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Relief Legislation would give Towns the authority to substantially reduce penalties for late payments of County, Town and Special District taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Relief Legislation would greatly reduce penalties as stated below; and

• If you pay by April 30: NO PENALTY

If you pay by May 30:
If you pay by June 30:
If you pay by June 30:
If you pay by July 15th:
If you pay from July 16th – July 31st:
Penalty - 0.5% (2% standard penalty)
Penalty - 1.5% (7% standard penalty)
Penalty - 5% (7% standard penalty)

• If you pay after July 31st: Penalty - 7%

WHEREAS, the Tax Relief Law provides consistent dates and discounts for all taxes as the Receiver of Taxes cannot legally accept partial payments of a Tax Bill; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Relief Law would provide Towns with the ability to pay the different jurisdiction tax warrants on time, including but not limited to 60% of the taxes due by May 25, 2020 to the County Commissioner of Finance, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the proposed legislation allows Towns to opt-out of this provision of the law, in whole or only with respect to Town and Town district taxes or assessments;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of North Castle Town Board fully supports the adoption of the Tax Relief Law, amending Section 283.221;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution is provided to the Westchester County Board of Legislators, the Westchester County Executive and the Westchester County Attorney.
