A Public Hearing was held to consider a Local Law regarding Town Code Amendments to Chapter 127, Building Code Administration and Enforcement, Section 127-17, Inspections; and Chapter 275 Subdivision of Land, Sections 275-18, Inspections of improvements, and 275-38, Inspection fees; to permit the Building Department to require escrow accounts for the cost of inspections by Town engineering consultants and professionals.

A Public Hearing was held to consider a Local Law to amend Chapter 355, Zoning, of the Code of the Town of North Castle permitting vehicle fueling and service stations in the Commercial Business (CB) Zoning District and creating additional CB District requirements pertaining to vehicles and service stations.
