A Public Hearing was held to consider the 2022 Town and Special Districts Preliminary Budgets.

A Public Hearing was reconvened to consider a Local Law to repeal Chapter 292 of the Town of North Castle Town Code entitled Telecommunication Facilities and create a new Chapter 292 entitled Wireless Communication Facilities.

## RESOLUTION

**Action:** To Issue a Negative Declaration Under the State

Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA)

**Date of Approval:** November 17, 2021

WHEREAS the Town of North Castle is performing upgrades to the existing North Castle Sewer District No. 2 Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). The proposed improvements may include equipment upgrades and improvements at their existing wastewater treatment plant, hereinafter referred to as "said Actions", and

WHEREAS said Actions require review under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), per 6NYCRR Part 617, and

WHEREAS said Actions are classified as Unlisted Actions as they do not exceed the Type I thresholds included in 6NYCRR Part 617, Section 617.4(b), and

WHEREAS a Short or Full Environmental Assessment Form may be prepared for an Unlisted Action, and

WHEREAS multiple agencies have approval or funding authority over said Actions, and

WHEREAS the Town of North Castle Town Board will process this Unlisted Action as an uncoordinated review under SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, under the uncoordinated review option, each involved agency acts as a lead agency, and independently conducts an environmental review and determines the significance of the action and If all involved agencies issue negative declarations, the project may go forward; and

WHEREAS the Town of North Castle and their consultants have prepared and filed a Full Environmental Assessment Form which identifies the potential environmental impacts which may result from said Actions, and

WHEREAS, the potential impacts as enumerated below were reviewed by the Town of North Castle with consultation from Town consultants, and determined to have "no or small impacts" (see Attached Parts 2 and 3 of the EAF):

- Impact on Land;
- Impact on Geological Features;
- Impact on Groundwater;
- Impact on Surface Water
- Impact on Plants and Animals;
- Impact on Flooding;
- Impact on Agricultural Resources;
- Impact on Aesthetic Resources;
- Impacts on Air;
- Impact on Historic and Archeological Resources;
- Impact on Open Space/Recreation;
- Impact on Critical Environmental Areas;
- Impact on Transportation;
- Impact on Energy;
- Impact on Noise, Odor and Light;
- Impact on Human Health;
- Consistency with Community Plans;
- Consistency with Community Character; and

WHEREAS, the completed Part 3 of the EAF indicated how impacts have been avoided, minimized and/or mitigated to the extent practicable, and

WHEREAS, said Actions will result in improvements to the existing wastewater treatment plant and regional surface water quality.

Therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town of North Castle declares that, based on the Environmental Record which has been prepared, the project will result in no significant adverse environmental impacts and that a Negative Declaration under SEQRA is therefore issued for this project.

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## ORDER CALLING PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD ON DECEMBER 8, 2021

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of North Castle (herein called "Town Board" and "Town", respectively), in the County of Westchester, New York, on behalf of the Town of North Castle Sewer District No. 2 (the "District"), and has directed Environmental Design and Research, a professional engineering firm licensed in New York (the "Engineer"), to prepare a map, plan and report for the District's sewer system improvements, including but not limited to, the acquisition, construction and reconstruction of improvements to the District's wastewater treatment plant (the "Project"); and all of the forgoing to include all necessary site work, equipment, apparatus and other improvements and costs incidental thereto; and pursuant to the direction of the Town, the Engineer has completed and filed with the Town Board such map and plan for said improvement to facilities of the District, where the same are available during regular office hours for examination by any persons interested in the subject matter thereof, including the estimated cost thereof;

WHEREAS, the Engineer has estimated the maximum cost of the Project to be \$4,800,000; which amount shall be allocated and charged as the cost of improving the facilities of the District and shall be borne by the District; and

WHEREAS, the proposed method of financing the cost of the Project, in whole or in part, shall be by the issuance of serial bonds of the Town maturing in annual installments over a period not exceeding forty (40) years, offset by federal and state grants received in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), constituting Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law, and 6 N.Y.C.R.R., Regulations Part 617, the Town Board has duly considered the impact the project may have on the environment and has determined that the project is an Unlisted Action as defined in Section 617.2(al) of the SEQRA regulations and no further environmental review is required;

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing with respect to the undertaking of the Project, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, in accordance with the provisions of Section 202-b of the Town Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of North Castle will be held at the Town Hall, 15 Bedford Road, Armonk, New York, on December 8, 2021 at 7:30 p.m. o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) for the purpose of a public hearing to consider if it is in the public interest to undertake the Project at a maximum cost of

\$4,800,000, and to hear all persons interested in the subject matter thereof concerning the same and for such other action on the part of the Town Board with relation thereto as may be required by law; and be it

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Town Clerk publish at least once in The Journal News, a newspaper designated as the official newspaper of the Town for such publication, and post on the sign board of the Town maintained pursuant to subdivision 6 of Section 30 of the Town Law, a copy of this Order, certified by said Town Clerk, the first publication thereof and said posting to be not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date of such public hearing.

## RESOLUTION

**Action:** Adoption of the 2022 Westchester County, NY

Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

**Date of Approval:** November 17, 2021

WHEREAS, all jurisdictions within Westchester County have exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment, and the County and local economy; and

WHEREAS; pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre and post disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, a coalition of Westchester County municipalities with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies within Westchester County; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating and revising this strategy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the North Castle Town Board:

- 1) Adopts in its entirety, the 2022 Westchester County Hazard Mitigation Plan (the "Plan") as the jurisdiction's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, and resolves to execute the actions identified in the Plan that pertain to this jurisdiction.
- 2) Will use the adopted and approved portions of the Plan to guide pre- and post-disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.
- Will coordinate the strategies identified in the Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.
- 4) Will continue its support of the Mitigation Planning Committee as described within the Plan.
- 5) Will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all participants in this Plan.
- 6) Will incorporate mitigation planning as an integral component of government and partner operations.
- 7) Will provide an update of the Plan in conjunction with the County no less than every five years.
