Local Law to amend the Town Zoning Map to reclassify a 21.89-acre portion of Parcel ID 108.03-1-62.1 from the OBH Office Business Hotel Zoning District to R-MF-SCH Residential Multifamily Senior Citizen Housing Zoning District, and establishing requirements for that 21.89-acre portion of the property.
